Part Two, "Who touched me?" the disciples said, "Everybody." "Master," they said in exasperation, "the multitude throng you and press you."

Jesus drew crowds quicker than a fire engine can, and everybody wanted to get close enough to see and hear him. There was a lot of shoving and elbowing and toe-stomping, and the disciples got tired of it. Their answer was no better than the crowd's. If you are "everybody" you are still "nobody." Just a face in the crowd. a number in an account book you become depersonalized.

"Who touched me" Jesus answer was **"Somebody."** Look at Luke 8:46 "Jesus said, "Somebody has touched me: for I perceive that the virtue is gone out of me."

Everybody is somebody to Jesus. He cares for the poor, the sick, the hurt, the lost. He sees the individual in the crowd.

The little woman came and confessed and testified that something beautiful happen to her when she touched Jesus. The woman became a somebody in the presence of Jesus.
