PASTORS CORNER

Good Morning FCC Family,

As we turn the page into a new year, I want to begin with a heartfelt **THANK YOU!** The love offering you shared with me and the rest of the staff at Christmas was truly overwhelming—in the very best way. Your generosity was a tremendous blessing, and I want you to know how deeply grateful we are. More than the gift itself, it was the love behind it that meant so much. It is a gift to serve a church with such a huge heart, a church that consistently looks for ways to care for, encourage, and bless others.

That generous spirit was on full display throughout the Advent and Christmas season. So many of you poured your time, energy, and gifts into making this season meaningful and beautiful. Thank you to our Advent candle readers, our bell choir and choir members, and to Amy and Jessica for the countless hours they invested through music and leadership. Thank you as well to everyone who decorated the sanctuary, prepared candles and communion, welcomed guests, and served quietly behind the scenes. Advent does not “just happen”—it happens because faithful people show up and serve. Once again, FCC did exactly that, and I am so grateful.

As we move into the new year, I also want to share a few important housekeeping notes:

- **Pastor's Bible Study** will resume:
 - Monday evenings beginning **January 26 at 6:00 PM**
 - Wednesday mornings beginning **January 28 at 10:00 AM**
- **Youth Group format changes** will begin on Sunday, January 25, as we try a new schedule for the next few months:
 - 1st & 3rd Sundays: Combined Middle School + High School Youth Group *and Club 3–5, from 10:15 AM–12:00 PM*
 - 2nd & 4th Sundays: Middle School + High School Youth Group only, from 10:15 AM–12:00 PM
 - 5th Sundays: A family event for all ages (*Our first 5th Sunday event will take place in March*)
- Plans are still being discussed about whether to offer a second round of GriefShare this spring or wait until the fall. If we wait, we will offer a Lenten Bible study this spring instead.
 - If you are interested in a specific Bible study topic or format, please let me know!

I also want to say how genuinely excited I am about the year ahead. God is doing good and meaningful work in and through First Christian Church, and I feel incredibly blessed to be part of it—with you. I am thankful for this church, for your faithfulness, and for the ways the Lord continues to lead us forward together. I truly believe the best is still ahead, and I can't wait to see all that God has in store for FCC in the months to come.

As we look a little farther down the road, it's also worth remembering that **in 2030, First Christian Church will celebrate 175 years of ministry**—which is now just four years away. That's a remarkable milestone and a powerful testimony to God's faithfulness across generations. My hope is that when we reach that moment, we won't just be celebrating our history, but the ministry God has done through this church—lives changed, souls saved, and people growing in faith. Over the next few years, I pray we will continue to dream and listen together, asking how we can live fully into our calling to help people **Believe in Christ, Behave as Christ, and Become like Christ**, and what God may be inviting us to invest in and work toward now. The story of FCC is still being written, and I'm grateful to be walking into that future alongside you.

FIRST CUTS FROM THE BOARD

At its most recent meeting, the Board approved the finalized job descriptions and hours for two new staff positions: **Children's Director** and **Youth Director**. With this approval, both positions are now officially open and have been posted on our website and Facebook. We are eager to welcome new staff into these roles, so please help spread the word to anyone who may feel called to serve in this important ministry.

We will begin reviewing applications and conducting interviews as qualified candidates apply, with applications requested by **January 31**.

In addition, the Board approved the New Building Committee's current proposed building layout. With this approval, the committee will move forward with securing a more detailed drawing of the proposed layout and a rough cost estimate based on that design. Once this information is available, the next step will be to present the layout and estimated costs to the congregation before proceeding with hiring a full set of architectural building plans.
